755 - PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT

Responsibility: Principal, Staff and School Council

This Policy was last ratified by School Council in September, 2024.

PURPOSE:

GUIDELINES:

- Working With Children checks are required by parent volunteers.
- School operational guidelines may change due to special circumstances (e.g. COVID19), this will affect ways in which parents are able to assist within the school. Parents, and the school, will comply with any such guidelines.
- The Principal in consultation with School Council may vary this Policy if circumstances require it.
