## STUDENT LEARNING CONFERENCES

Unfortunately the Meet and Greet that was scheduled for earlier this week was postponed. The purpose of the Meet and Greet was to provide families with an opportunity to connect with their child's teacher in an informal way. This is in line with our Reporting to Parents Policy.

Upon reflection on the timing and purpose of the first "official" meeting between parents/carers and teachers in 2021, we have decided to schedule Student Learning Conferences in Week 2 of Term 2 instead of the Meet and Greet. A second Student Learning Conference will occur at the usual time (early Term 3).

During Week 2 in Term 2, teachers will be available for Student Learning Conferences from **3.40 pm to 4.30 pm Monday 26th April to Thursday 29th April**. The Student Learning Conference will be optional for parents/carers and their child to attend. However, it is strongly encouraged for students with an Individual Learning Plan (ILP) to attend a Student Learning Conference with their parents/carers and their teacher. Teachers will notify families during the first two days of Term 2 if their child will have an ILP for Term 2. A notice will be sent out to families with the first newsletter in Term 2 to indicate the afternoons they are available, a timetable will be then sent out.

## AUSKICK

Auskick sessions will be held within school hours at KWPS this year, at lunchtime on **Tuesdays from 20 April to 8 June 2021** (see the attached flyer).

Paul Harry has agreed to run the sessions with the assistance of the school's 2 SEDA students (Blake Damon & Jaymes Crees – both Katandra U/17 players). Laura Lawn will co-ordinate the program and help run the sessions.

The sessions will be held for both Auskick registered participants and general students but they must notify the office or Laura if they would like to participate and they must commit to participating for the whole 40 minute session.

Registration is not compulsory however there are some benefits of registering. If you register through Auskick, your child will receive a pack, be eligible to possibly participate in a grid game at half time of an AFL game in Melbourne and be involved with a grid game at half time of a local game at Katandra West Football Netball Club.

The plan is to trial this for 12 months and reassess at the end of the season.

### **What is Net Set Go:**

The Net Set Go program is for boys and girls aged 5—9 years old. It provides children with a positive introduction to netball, incorporating skill activities, minor games, music, dance, and modified matches.

Over the term your child will learn:

- How to throw, pass and catch a netball.
- How to take off and land safely.
- How to pivot and change direction.
- The mysterious art of goal shooting.
- Some basic movement skills and techniques.
- Why teamwork is so important.
- How to play fair, respect your umpire and have fun.

### **When will it start:**
