Parents/carers will be able to send a list of what they would like to purchase and the money in with their child. Another option will be to make a secure credit card payment online and send the receipt number in to school as proof of payment. We understand that this is different and poses challenges, however I am confident we can make it work. We are aware that sometimes books purchased through the Book Fair are intended as gifts, so arrangements can be made in these instances. During the Book Fair, you will be able to contact the school by phone to resolve any issues that may arise.
