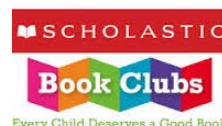
School Fees

BOOK CLUB is due next Thursday 8th June.



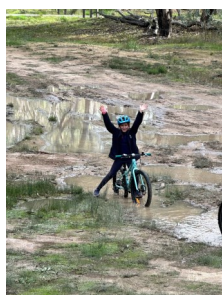

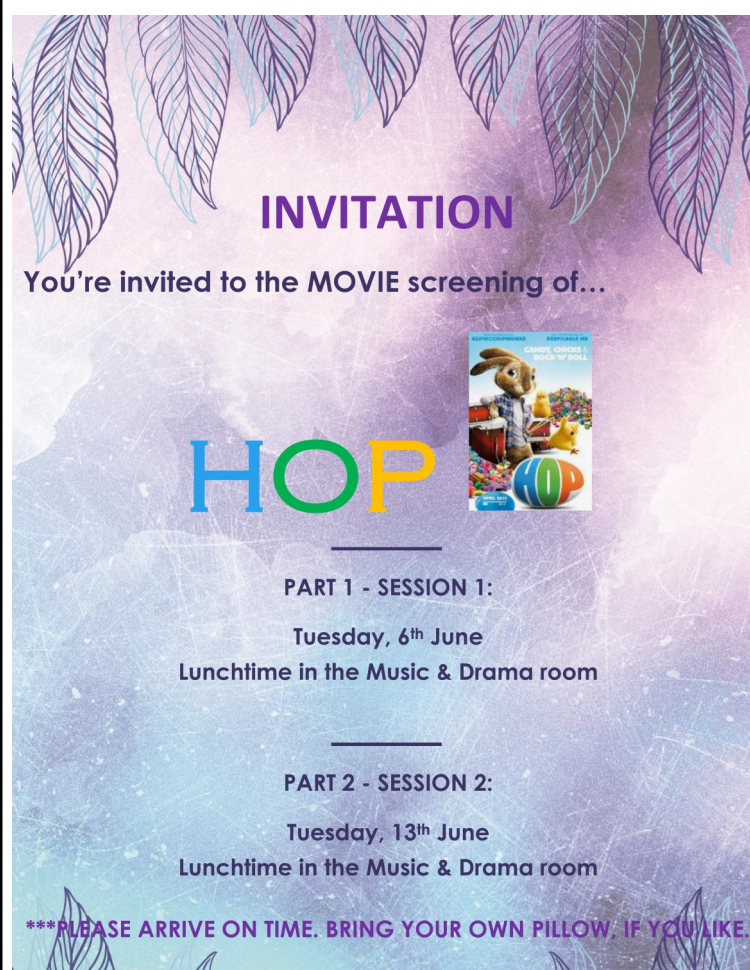
