NAPLAN ONLINE COORDINATED PRACTICE TEST

In 2019 our Year 3 and Year 5 students will complete NAPLAN online. The exception is the Year 3 Writing test which is completed on paper by our Year 3 students. The NAPLAN Online assessment window is **14-24 May**. Families of students in Year 3 and Year 5 will receive further details closer to this date. As part of student familiarization with the NAPLAN Online environment, there will be a Coordinated Practice Test (CPT) **tomorrow morning, 28 March**. The results of the CPT are not used as part of the final assessment that is reported to parents and the school. The CPT is to provide students with the opportunity to experience the NAPLAN Online environment and familiarize themselves with the different types of questions.
